ELIGIBILITY/CRITERIA

- For Master's degree, applicants must have a Bachelor's degree at least upper second class with honours with a minimum CGPA to 3.50. For Doctorate programmes, applicants must have a Master's degree or equivalent.
- Application is open to students who have enrolled in full time postgraduate studies at UCSI University.

RESEARCH-BASED PROGRAMME

The **UCSI University Trust Graduate Scholarship** is offered to qualified Malaysian and International candidates enrolled in any of the **Master's degree or Doctorate programmes by research** at UCSI University.

Successful applicants will be awarded a full or partial tuition fee waiver for postgraduate studies at UCSI University. Scholarship quantum to be decided by the Selection Committee. A monthly stipend may be accorded to the candidate for an agreed duration which is subject to the funding availability and the Selection Committee's approval.

ELIGIBILITY/CRITERIA

- For Master's degree, applicants must have a Bachelor's degree at least upper second class with honours with a minimum of CGPA 3.30. For Doctorate programmes, applicants must have a Master's degree or equivalent.
- Application is open to students who have enrolled in full time postgraduate studies by research at UCSI University.
- Applicant's research project proposal must be part of the University's project under supervision of the respective faculty.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A) Coursework and mixed-mode Programme*

- 1. The graduate scholarship awarded is in the form of a full or partial tuition fee waiver and is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
- 2. The candidate must be a full-time registered student at UCSI University and must meet both the academic and English requirements. Duration of the Scholarship will follow the minimum duration of the programme enrolled in or will follow a pre-agreed duration.
- 3. Candidates are expected to assist their supervisor and/or the University as Research Assistant and/or Teaching Assistant for a pre-agreed duration. The nature of the assistantship will be determined by the Dean of the Faculty to which the candidate belongs to. In the absence of the dean, the Vice-Chancellor will make the final decision on candidacy and the terms and conditions therein.
- 4. At the end of each semester, the candidate's supervisor will assess the candidate's performance in the programme and make a recommendation on the continuation of the graduate scholarship or otherwise. The Dean of the Faculty will give the final approval.
- 5. The candidate must meet minimum performance requirements set by the Faculty throughout the semesters. A warning letter will be given if the candidate fails to maintain the required performance. If the situation persists, the graduate scholarship will be withdrawn.

B) Research-based Programme**

- 1. The graduate scholarship awarded is in the form of a full or partial tuition fee waiver and is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
- 2. The candidate must be a full-time registered student at UCSI University and meet both the academic and English Requirements.
- 3. Duration of the graduate scholarship will follow the minimum duration of the programme enrolled in or will follow a pre-agreed duration.
- 4. Candidates are expected to assist their supervisor and/or the University as Research Assistant and/or Teaching Assistant for a pre-agreed duration. The nature of the assistantship will be determined by the Dean of the Faculty to which the candidate belongs to.
- 5. Candidates are required to submit a Research Project Proposal to the respective faculty within the first semester of their postgraduate programme.
- 6. Based on the Research Project Proposal, subject to the Selection Committee's approval, a monthly stipend may be accorded to the candidate for a certain duration.
- 7. Publication of research in Indexed Journals (either Scopus or Web of Science Index Journal) is required by the candidates by the end of fellowship and will follow the minimum duration of the programme enrolled in or will follow a pre-agreed duration:
 - Master's degree programme minimum 1 Journal Publication
 - Doctorate programme minimum 2 Journal Publications
- 8. At the end of each semester, the candidate's supervisor and dean will assess his or her performance in the programme and make a recommendation on the continuation of the graduate scholarship or otherwise. The Dean of the Faculty will give the final approval.
- 9. The candidate must meet minimum performance requirements set by the Faculty throughout the semesters. A warning letter will be given if the candidate fails to maintain the required performance. If the situation persists, the graduate scholarship will be withdrawn.
- 10. The candidate needs to submit a progress report to the Faculty and UCSI University Trust every semester.
- 11. If there is a position offered by UCSI University or UCSI Group, the recipient should commit himself or herself to work for UCSI for a minimum of one year (Master's degree programme) and two years (Doctorate programme) after he or she has received the letter from Senate as an indication of the completion of his or her graduate programme.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Scholarship application is to be made prior to the commencement of applicant's postgraduate studies at the University. Admission to the programme is required for scholarship application. Applicants must submit their application form for prompt approval. Late and incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 2. Shortlisted applicants will be informed by UCSI University Trust via email regarding the date, time, and venue of the interview within two weeks from the submission deadline
- 3. While on UCSI University Trust Graduate scholarship, all candidates are NOT to be bonded by other educational institutions or organisations.
- 4. The scholarship awarded is in the form of a tuition fee waiver for the programme and duration offered and is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
- 5. All fees and cost that are not covered by the scholarship are to be borne by the candidate, which shall include but not limited to the semesterly Medical Plan payment applicable.
- 6. All candidates have to sign an agreement with UCSI University Trust and observe the terms and conditions as set therein.
- 7. All information provided by the candidate must be true and correct. If inaccurate information is provided the scholarship will be withdrawn without prior notice. In such event, the candidate must reimburse UCSI University Trust the amount of scholarship allocation (excluding monthly stipend) received up to the day when the scholarship is withdrawn.
- 8. The candidate agrees to pay back the amount of scholarship received up to date in case of withdrawal before the completion, and all the entitlements will automatically cease with immediate effect.
- 9. In the event of a dispute on the eligibility of the scholarship, the decision made by the Selection Committee is final and no appeals will be entertained.
- 10. The number of scholarships and the quantum to be offered is at the discretion of Selection Committee.
- 11. UCSI University Trust reserves the right to alter and amend the terms and conditions in this letter without prior notice.
- 12. Tuition fee waivers are not cumulative. If recipients qualify for the other UCSI Scholarship, Grant, Assistantship or Sibling's scheme, recipients will be entitled to either one that they are eligible for.

DECLARATION BY APPLICANT
